


NEW BUSINESS:

Mr. O'Rourke asked about an e-mail that was being circulated concerning some delinquent property taxes and the changing of tax values on some property. Councilman Rick Stallard explained that the land owner is trying to bring his past due taxes up to date. He also explained that when a building sits on multiple parcels, the building value is assigned to one of the parcels with the other parcels being shown with no building.
