SUPERINTENDENTS REPORT:

The bid opening for the West Main Street detention basin project will be held on April 26, 2010 at 1:00 PM. BOPA customer Summit Twin Oaks Realty had a water pipe break causing the usage of 109,000 gallons of water. The customer is asking for a credit on the sewer portion of the bill because the water did not enter the sewer system. The board approved to reduce the sewer bill. There will be a Wednesday meeting with AMP-Ohio to discuss the generating station that was being built in Meigs County.

OFFICE MANAGERS REPORT:

Mrs. Kilgore gave the extended payment plans. She also noted that a previous council member was owed money from OPERS from the 1970's. The amount was not paid thirty years ago and with penalties and interest the amount will be \$1031.54. Mr. Johnson moved to pay the bill. The motion was seconded by Mr. Greer. The motion passed unanimously.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:


Village resident Rich Demastes has asked Mr. Johnson about the raising of guarantee deposit rates. No changes to deposit rates are planned.


NEW BUSINESS:
