Mrs. Shultz reported that Mr. Bittaker had received a quote from D & M Painting of \$24,840 to paint the water tower. This is about half of any of the previous estimates. The estimate is only good for two weeks. Mr. Greer spoke in favor of accepting the bid. He noted that even with the current water project being planned, it may be 4 to 5 years before a new tower will be built. Mr. Landis moved to accept the bid from D & M. The motion was seconded by Mr. Barbera. The motion passed unanimously.
