Mr. Bittaker said that the Water Line Project is going well. There is 1200 feet of pipe remaining to be installed. An automobile accident damaged the remaining uninstalled pipe and new pipe is being delivered to replace the damaged pipe. The damaged pipe does not belong to BOPA.

Mr. Bittaker has ordered a new light fixture with an LED bulb for the downtown area. If the fixture can be installed and works as advertised, more will be ordered to add illumination to the downtown area. The cost for the planned replacement fixtures will total \$17,000.00. The use of LED bulbs will allow the Board to re-coop the cost of the fixtures relatively quickly.


