BOPA will replace 30 feet of pipe and cover it with dirt at a cost of about \$1,500.00 plus labor. There was a question about who owns the property but Mr. Bittaker said he felt that it was a BOPA drain so BOPA should fix it regardless of who owns the property.

Mr. Landis moved to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Mr. Barbera. The motion passed unanimously.

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
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The meeting adjourned at 6:59 PM.
