Some of the current debt will end in 2024 and more will have to be added to upgrade the water system. Mr. Bittaker learned that Seville will be receiving approximately \$480,000 in COVID relief money and asked that, depending on Village finances, as much of the money as possible be used toward water and sewer upgrades.
