The amount of federal ARPA funds for the Village will be \$254,00.00. The original amount was over \$400,000 but that amount was reduced to give money to various townships. The Mayor met with GPD Engineering and Bill Hudson to discuss sharing the money for the Route 3 waterline project because the project will have an effect on both the Guilford Fire Department and Guilford Township in general.

The Itron meter reading has become obsolete. It will cost approximately \$25,000.00 to replace the units. More information will be presented at future meetings.

Mr. Bittaker noted that both Marc Heidelman and Austin Banks have been with BOPA for 5 years and are making excellent progress. Mr. Bittaker recommended that both men be promoted to the position of Tech A Level 4 with a corresponding pay raise to \$32.52 per hour effective August 9th. 
