Superintendent's Report:

Mr. Bittaker submitted a price to NS Corporation of \$30,000 for the installation of the sewer line for the Shell gasoline station. The Shell station is requesting that they not have to pay the entire amount up front. They would prefer some type of payment program. Mr. Bittaker recommend that the terms of payment be less than two years. It was noted that interest should be added since this would constituent a loan from BOPA. If the bill is not paid, a property tax assessment or property lien would be possible recourses to recoup BOPA money. It was suggested that Shell obtain a bank loan rather that have BOPA agree to an extended payment option. The owners of the Shell station have been invited to the next BOPA meeting and the issue will be discussed further at that time.
