March 16, 2026

Mr. Greer called the meeting to order at 6:45 PM.

Privilege of the floor:

Mike Migliore, from American Municipal Power (AMP), gave a presentation on Seville's power supply portfolio. Mr. Migliore touched on the different types of projects that Seville is a part of through AMP, the annual usage, the energy sources that make up the portfolio, and reasons for increased costs in capacity. Mr. Migliore also reviewed the block of power from Bright Mountain Solar that AMP suggests Seville should purchase for future use. Mr. Migliore ended the presentation by answering questions from the audience.

Superintendent's Report:

Mr. Bittaker reported on the windstorm power outage Friday, March 13, 2026. We had multiple crossarms and poles damaged resulting in power outages. Today's power outage was caused by a tree falling on our lines and knocking out the 69Kv breaker. While this affected the whole village, overall, the power was out for approximately 30 minutes. Mr. Greer commented on what a testament to the work our crew of 4, overseen by Mr. Bittaker, in their dedication to the around-the-clock service we provide to the community.
