To Whom it May Concern:

The Seville Board of Public Affairs (BOPA) is going to be replacing an 80-year-old water main along State Route 3/Center Street. Enclosed is a map of the water line to be replaced. This large project is scheduled to begin around April 2024 with completion by November 2024.

While most of the work to be completed will be focused on the public right-of-way, work on some private property may be required to reestablish water connections to the new main line. Please be assured that any sidewalks, curbing, and lawns disturbed by the work will be fully restored. However, some trees in the right-of-way will be removed as the root systems are disastrous to the water lines and they will not be replaced.

BOPA is going to make every effort to keep water service on to homes for the duration of the project, nevertheless, there may be times when water will need to be shut off for short periods of time. Traffic will be controlled during construction, and every endeavor will be made to always allow access to homes and businesses.
